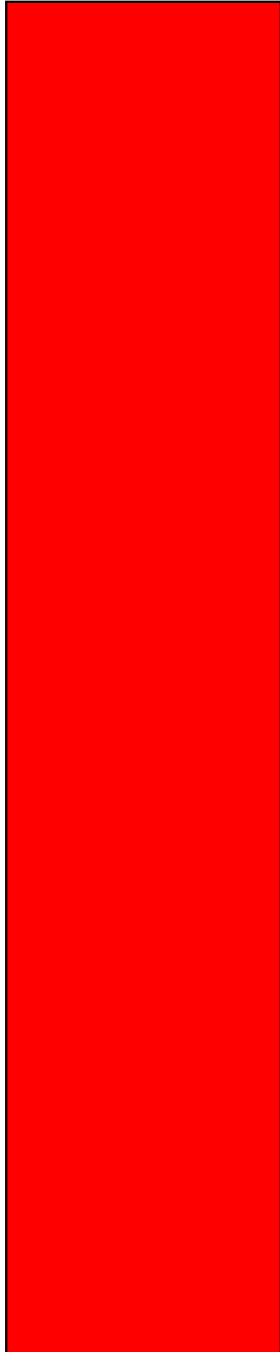

Gabriele Hoffmann teaches Art History with a focus on Modernism. Her lecture starts with the brief movement of Realism leading to Impressionism, then following the first half of the 20th century from figurative Expressionism to Surrealism and Abstract Expressionism, ending with Andy Warhol's *Brillo Box* (1960s). Another lecture on 20th Century art takes us up close to the present. Gabriele has a Masters degree in art history from Hunter University, New York, which required the completion of an 85-page thesis; her topic was Paul Klee's Late Work. - She is trilingual, has studied, lived & worked in Munich, Frankfurt, Paris & NYC (20+ years), and has seen most of the 19th and 20th century iconic artworks in the original. Gabriele has traveled to five continents and enjoys taking photographs as her art form.
