### ROSEMARY HURKAMP (Ed.D.)

Having grown up in Westchester County and New York City, Rosemary pursued her higher education at Boston University School of Management and earned a doctorate in adult and higher education there. She was a high school teacher, business school director, university dean and adjunct professor, before becoming president of her own training and consulting company for 20 years in the D.C. area, with clients both here and abroad. Art has always been an avocation and, although tweaked by some fine instructors from Boston University, Harvard and the Ringling School, Rosemary is primarily a self-taught, naïve/folk artist. She works in acrylic, oil and watercolor, producing large paintings as well as miniatures on various surfaces. Her paintings are in corporate and private collections worldwide.

A part-time Hilton Head resident since the early 1960s, Dr. Hurkamp and her husband, Alois Meidenbauer, now reside on the island, where Rosemary enjoys teaching art courses for adults and children and exhibiting her work locally as well as in galleries at other locales.

Some current exhibits include the Contemporary American Folk Art Gallery in New York City, the Jarett-Thor Fine Arts Gallery in Colonial Beach, Virginia, the SOBA Gallery in Bluffton, and the Plantation House in Hilton Head Plantation in Hilton Head.
