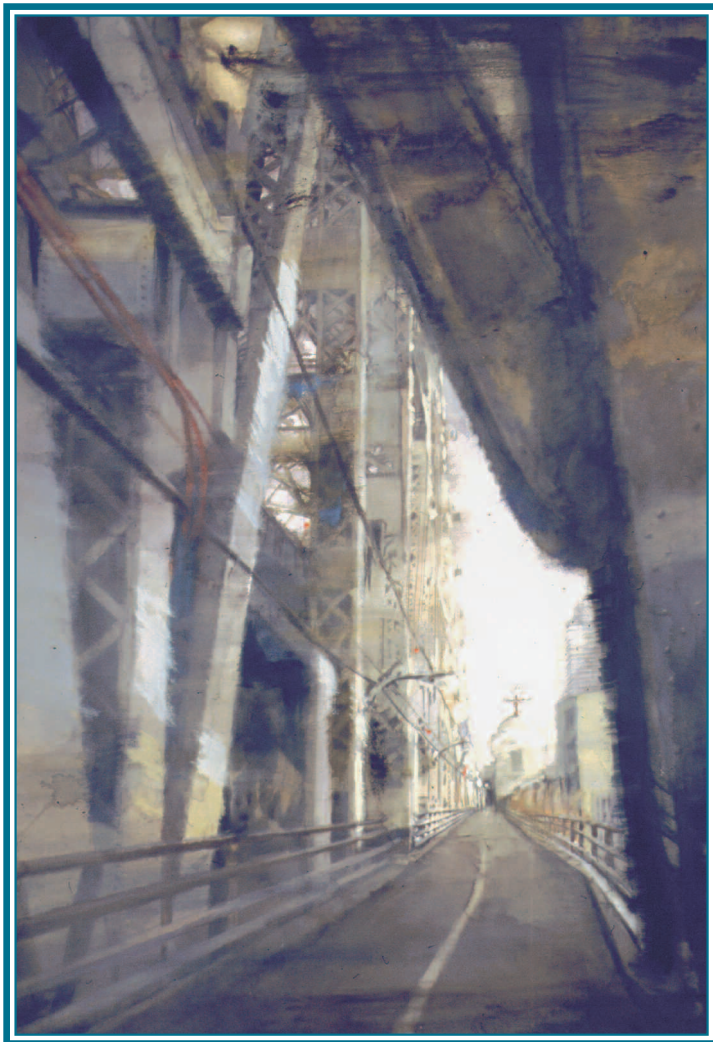

Dean Mitchell is a native of Quincy, Florida. He received his formal training at Columbus College of Art and Design and after worked as a leading designer for Hallmark Card.

In 1983 Dean left the commercial field in order to focus all his energies on his painting. His paintings are realistic presentations of both urban and rural America. He has mastered the disciplines of portraiture, landscape and still life in both oil and watercolor. His work touches young and old, novice and expert.

Dean's talent has been well recognized and he has been an active member in the American Watercolor Society, the National Watercolor Society, the Miniature Artists of America, the Allied Artists of America, the National Society of Painters in Casein and Acrylic, the Knickerbocker Artists and the Santa Fe Watercolor Society, of which he was president in 1993.

In 1992 Mitchell was one of the five finalists in the \$250,000 Hubbard Award for Excellence, Ruidoso, New Mexico and received the \$50,000 Grand Prize for the Arts in the Parks competition in 1999. In 1995 the U.S. Postal Service commissioned Mitchell to do a series of Jazz stamps.

Today, Mitchell's paintings may be found in the permanent collections of the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art, St. Louis Museum, Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art, Margaret Harwell Museum, Hubbard Museum, Mississippi Museum of Art and the Arkansas Art Center. The list of private collections is equally impressive.

Two books have been written about the art of Mr. Mitchell: *The Art of Dean Mitchell: The Early Years* and *The Watercolors of Dean Mitchell: Beauty in the Real*.

Dean Mitchell is intensely aware of his commitment to inspire future artists and we are indeed fortunate to have this talented, professional and unique artist serve as juror of our National Juried Exhibition this year.

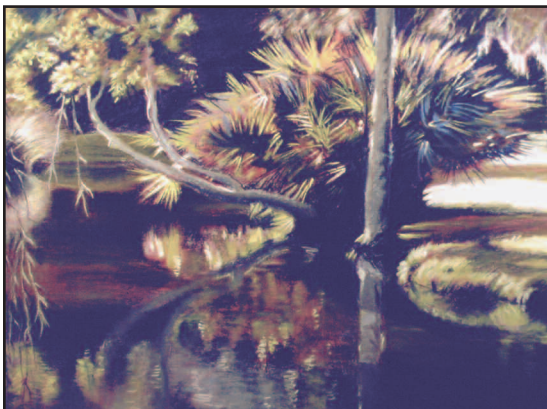

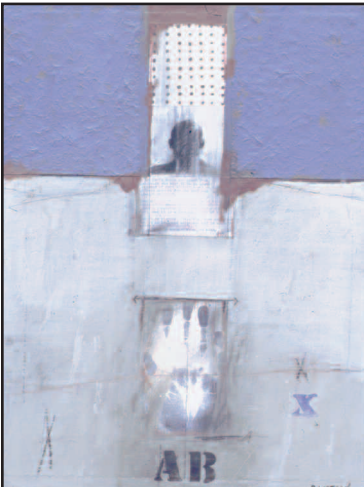
