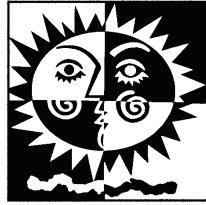

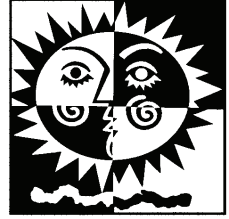

Pat San Soucie, born in Minneapolis in 1931, still feels her Mid-western roots. A graduate of the University of Wisconsin with a Bachelor's Degree in Applied Arts, she continued her studies throughout her married life, exploring fine arts in painting and drawing. The family moved several times, crossing the country from Oregon to New York, Missouri and New Jersey, only to return to the great north-west in Clackamas, Oregon. "We never lost a fondness for the Oregon scene. I feel I just might grow up in this vast and energizing area because everything – the mountains, the trees – grows tall."

Pat's travels have given her the opportunity to join a host of groups. The list of art society memberships is long and impressive: American Watercolor Society (D.F.), National Watercolor Society, Watercolor Honor Society, Rocky Mountain National Watercolor Society, North West Watercolor Society, New Jersey Watercolor Society, ISEA, Ohio Watercolor Society, Experimental Art Association and Watercolor Society of Oregon. She has won awards in each of these and maintains honorary memberships in several of them. Her work is in the collections of seven museums in the United States, Europe and Asia, and in museum libraries as well as private and corporate foundation collections.

Workshops and teaching have occupied Pat's life for nearly thirty-five years. She has taught all over the United States and internationally in Mexico and France. Pat has also participated in painting exchanges in Italy and Taiwan. As a result of her many workshop connections, she has served as judge and juror for at least forty watercolor groups and enthusiastically notes that she has learned and grown with each.

Pat's paintings have been included in ten books, including the upcoming edition of "Splash 10" and have been featured in seven magazine articles. She has had work accepted in fourteen shows this year alone, winning awards in four of them.

A tireless artist and teacher, we are very pleased to have Pat as this year's Juror and trust her many experiences will bring much to bear on the awards process.
